So remember, you are not alone! And together we can and will defend our children’s innocence.







QUESTIONS TO ASK YOUR SCHOOL BEFORE THEY REDEFINE GENDER



Many parents feel their school isn't keeping them in the loop about measures being taken to accommodate students practicing gender fluidity.

Schools are reluctant to reveal policy, if any, around these issues.

Not only do you have a right to know your school's policy, you have a right to be involved in developing it.

P&C groups are a great means of interacting with your school about what to do if there are transgender students/staff.

To ensure transparency, ask your school to develop a policy in consultation with the P&C.

The policy should address:

1

WHAT TOILETS WILL TRANS STUDENTS USE?

Both sexes should feel safe in toilets and change rooms. Allowing kids to use whichever toilet they feel like can leave kids feeling uncomfortable if they find someone of a different biological sex to them in the change rooms.

3

WHERE WILL TRANS STUDENTS SLEEP ON SCHOOL CAMPS?

Will trans students be accommodated according to their biological sex? If not, will parents be advised and given the option not to have their child share sleeping accommodation with the trans student?

2

WHAT IS THE SCHOOL'S PRONOUN POLICY?

This may sound absurd, but an increasing number of schools and other workplaces are prohibiting 'misgendering' someone. Staff and students should not be compelled to use language that does not reflect biological fact.

WHAT IS THE SCHOOL'S POLICY FOR SPORTING TEAMS AND ACTIVITIES?

Will biological males be permitted to participate as females?

ADDRESSING YOUR P&C OR SIMILAR?

Here's some talking points to pack a punch...

- Schools should be safe places for kids to learn. They should not be a place for activists to push their own political agendas.
- And yet, gender activists are continuing to push the boundaries and introduce very adult concepts to our kids at an increasingly young age..
- Programs like the so-called 'Safe Schools' teach kids their gender is fluid and not based on biology.
- These programs tell kids that only they can know if they are a boy or a girl.
- These programs are growing in number and being quietly implemented in schools nation-wide without parental knowledge or consent.
- Victoria's government has sought to make 'Safe Schools'-like programs mandatory.
- Queensland's parliament has kept the list of so-called 'Safe Schools' secret.
- The truth is that not only are many schools taking radical gender ideology onboard to accommodate transgender staff and/or students, they're celebrating it with events like Wear it Purple Days, pressuring parents and children alike into participating.
- Stories from parents all over Australia keep surfacing – a transgender person addressed their child's school assembly, books promoting gender fluidity are in their school library, radical gender ideology is being taught either overtly or subliminally in their child's classes – story after story, the truth keeps coming out.
- But for the most part, parents are being kept in the dark about what is going on in their child's school, with no way of knowing what's being taught.
- For too long, and sometimes completely unknown to parents, gender activists in our education system have actioned what they believe best for our kids.
- What's even more frightening is that many states are legislating in favour of transgender rights over the rights of parents and over the rights of children.
- The state seems to be siding with the activists – they'd rather pacify them and avoid offending than make a stand for the sake of the innocence of our children.

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
- Now, you may think this all sounds a bit far-fetched, but Tasmania has already defied biology by making it optional to record sex on a birth certificate. And Victoria's government is pushing a bill that allows trans people to self-identify.
- Such measures directly affect our children in their schools – as the law goes, so goes their education system with things like de-gendered language and inappropriate storybooks normalizing transgenderism.
- Our governments' increasing efforts to accommodate transgenders comes at a price: our kids are being increasingly exposed to a harmful, radical agenda in their places of learning.
- Worse, they're being exposed to it at a time they are far too young to think it through critically. Gender activists in our education system are preying on a captive audience of the most receptive minds: our kids at school.
- The state seems to be siding with the activists – they'd rather pacify them and avoid offending than make a stand for the sake of the innocence of our children.
- As the transgender agenda increasingly becomes a national issue, now is the time to put procedures and processes in place to ensure our kids are safe in our school – now and into the future.
- Australia can't afford to take a leaf out of the UK's book – they recently passed laws which make LGBT school lessons compulsory from the age of 4, with parents not allowed to withdraw their children.
- We need to take this opportunity to take action against any gender ideology being taught in our school.
- There is a lack of transparency with regard to what is going on in our education system when it comes to gender ideology being taught to our kids.
- As parents, we have the right to know what our child is being taught and to remove them from classes with sexual content.
- The radical gender indoctrination in our schools is only getting worse; it's increasing and growing evermore popular/"in vogue".




IT FEELS GOOD TO BE YOURSELF

"Some people are boys. Some people are girls. Some people are both, neither, or somewhere in between."




WHO ARE YOU: THE KID'S GUIDE TO GENDER IDENTITY

"This brightly illustrated children's book provides a straightforward introduction to gender for anyone aged 4+."




GAYBC'S

Jazz’s story is based on her real-life experience and she tells it in a simple, clear way that will be appreciated by picture book readers, their parents, and teachers.”




RETHINKING NORMAL
